A Fairer Scotland for Carers?

We believe the Carers' (Scotland) Bill will only result in a fairer Scotland for carers if it sets out a **national** approach in specifying when a carer is entitled to support.

The current plan to base a carer's right to support on **local** eligibility criteria will lead to 32 different systems, inequity and unfairness.

The carers' voice is clear – the Bill will only be successful if it delivers rights in a consistent way for **all carers** in Scotland.
